Elevating the quintessential Tuscan country house to new heights of sophistication is the three-bedroomed Locker Cottage, which is set amidst a sprawling 2,230m² garden, rich in olive trees, lavender, rosemary and a host of other Mediterranean plants.

Two additional types of Maremma Cottages - Olive Trees and Horse Track – each offer a unique interior design theme to captivate the senses and reflect the environment. They, too, have three bedrooms and large decked terraces with loungers and outdoor hot tubs.

Each villa rental includes a VIP welcome, daily buffer breakfast, access to the spa and wellness facility and personalised concierge services. Guests can also enjoy the convenience of daily housekeeping, 24/7 security, and a range of amenities designed to ensure their stay gives unparalleled heights of indulgence. Other services are provided upon request, from private chef services to wellness treatments, in the comfort of your vilta.

Away from the villas, guests can unwind around one of the hotel's two swimming pools (either the heated indoor pool with saline water or the outdoor pool) by the 2,700 m² Espace Wellness Centre and MediSPA or, if preferred, get into shape (both body and soul) thanks to a fitness centre with Technogym equipment, bio-sauna with chromotherapy, Kneipp circuit, six massage and treatment cabins and tanning showers plus numerous other services.

kitchen is based on the flavours and colours of the nearby terrain with dishes prepared using organic produce from small, carefully selected local farms and local fishermen and, at certain times of the year, directly from the hotel's organic vegetable garden and orchard.

Each dish is carefully presented in a creative and modern fashion, ensuring that supper at the Dama Dama is a captivating journey through both the local terroir and Mediterranean cuisine; a sensory experience that excites the palate and takes you to the heart of gastronomic delight.

For more casual dining, there is the option of healthy Mediterranean dishes, again with local influences, on offer in the comfortable Club House Restaurant and its spacious wooden terrace overlooking the 9th green of the golf course and beyond. Both restaurants have an extensive list of fine local terrain and Italian wines to choose from whitst the olive oil on offer at every meal is made from olives harvested annually on the estate.

However there's no real need to venture from the Resort at all if you do not wish to as there are plenty of activities on offer within the confines of the Argentario estate; tennis and padel courts, jogging paths that meander through the golf course and the edge of the forest, a mini football pitch as well as an outdoor fitness station offer a range of opportunities to get the heart thumping.
